





Rehabilitation and assistance of neurological patients by means of robotic devices: Robotic exoskeleton for motor rehabilitation in neurological patients with upper limb motor deficit. The device must physically interact with patients exercising forces or executing movements in accordance with rehabilitation exercises defined by clinicians. In order to provide a quantitative evaluation of the specific physio pathological mechanisms, spontaneous recovery and functional ability, the device must be able to measure patients' clinical values (e.g., angular excursions, range of motion, stiffness, smoothness) during active and passive movements.

PROJECT/OBJECTIVES

Cardiopathy and especially ischemic cardiomyopathy are one of the main causes of death. The cause of myocardial infarction, in the majority of cases, is represented by the coronary artery obstruction for the deposition of a thrombus on an atherosclerotic lesion. The described technological solution should be a non-invasive instrument that can assess the lesion of deep vessels, qualifying the morphology of the atheromatous plaques and entity of the inflammation process. The function of this method must determine the probability that the plaque can start a intravasal repair process that may cause the blockage of the vessel. The aim of the investigation consists in the visualization of an image, at the most high resolution as possible, of the investigation area and also give some values on the composition of the plaque itself.

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Safe bronchial aspiration

PROJECT/OBJECTIVES

Bronchial aspiration is an invasive procedure potentially associated to clinically significant complications resulting from incorrect practice. One problem is the risk of tracheal mucosa injury due to an excessive advancement of the aspiration tube beyond the lower limit of the tracheal cannula. The availability of a device with a tracheostomy cannula integrated an aspiration system could make bronchial aspiration safer, preventing clinical complications such as granulomas, infections and bleeding of tracheal mucosa, while reducing the procedure time and consumables needed, thus becoming the clinical gold standard for the management of tracheostomy patients.

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

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
Point-of-use water treatment for organic-rich surface water

PROJECT/OBJECTIVES

The aim of this competition is to fund up to 5 feasibility studies to explore the development of a point-of-use (POU) water treatment system. It must consistently deliver water from high organic surface waters with no risk to human health. It must also be cost effective and low maintenance.

Most of Scotland's water supplies are served by surface waters high in organic matter. There is no reliable household solution on the market for treating this sort of water. Current technology is either too expensive or requires a lot of maintenance.

The solution must: meet the quality standards set out in the following [regulation](#), be affordable, close the water loop by recycling rain and grey water, provide a complete treatment from source to tap, and be automated.


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Phase 2-Timeline
